





PREAMBLE

Whereas, State Forest Research Institute (SFRI), Jabalpur established in 1963, is a research institute focusing its research activities in the fields of forestry research and biodiversity conservation in Madhya Pradesh. It has strength in not only identifying and articulating intellectual challenges straddling a number of disciplines of knowledge but also in mounting research, training and demonstration projects leading to development of specific problem based advanced technologies that help carry benefits to society at large.

Whereas, On July 15, 1954 Govt. M. H. College of Home Science and Science For Women came into existence with only Home Science classes. Mr. Parmanand Bhai Patel's, firm Mohanlal Hargovinddas donated Rs. One Lakh for the establishment of the college. On April 27, 1956 the foundation stone was laid down on 11 acres of land, situated in the heart of Jabalpur city, by the chief minister of MP. The college is affiliated to Rani Durgavati Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur which awards degrees to the students. University Grants Commission, New Delhi implemented the Autonomous Scheme in 1979. The M H College is one of the pioneering institutions of Madhya Pradesh that adopted the autonomous system in the Higher Education in 1988-89. - Progress of work of any individual collaborative research project/programme will be reviewed and approved by designated project officers of both parties, in accordance with its individual agreement.
- The final approval of any collaborative research project/programme will depend on the availability of the guaranteed support funds.
- Neither State Forest Research institute nor Govt. M.H. College of Home Science and Science for Women (Autonomous) Jabalpur will be held responsible for any Itability, and neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to any personal/institutional property to which this Memorandum relates.
- Research instrumentation facility and library facilities available with the first party and second party will be made available to the scientists, faculty and research scholars. However, the costs of specific consumable will be borne by the respective organization.

WHEREAS the "Second Party" is involved in basic and advanced research in subject of plant science, animal science, chemical science and environment sciences.

BACKGROUND

This MoU sets for the terms and understanding between the ICFRE- Tropical Forest Research Institute (TFRI) Mandla Road, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh- 482021 and Govt. M.H. College of Home Science and Science for Women (Autonomous) Jabalpur (M.P.) INDIA - 482002 to collaborate in basic and applied research programs, organizing joint Seminars, Conferences/Workshops and sharing research projects, publications and students internships.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, ICFRE- Tropical Forest Research Institute established in April 1987, is a research institute focusing its research activities in the fields of forestry research in Central India states viz., Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Maharashtra. It has strength in not only identifying and articulating intellectual challenges straddling a number of disciplines of knowledge but also in mounting research, training and demonstration projects leading to development of specific problem based advanced technologies that help carry benefits to society at large.

Whereas, On July 15, 1954 Govt. M.H. College of Home Science and Science for Women came into existence with only Home Science classes. Mr. Parmanand Bhai Patel's, firm Mohanlal Hargovinddas donated Rs. One Lakh for the establishment of the college. On April 27, 1956 the foundation stone was laid down on 11 acres of land, situated in the heart of Jabalpur city, by the chief minister of MP. The college is affiliated to Rani Durgavati Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur which awards degrees to the students. University Grants Commission, New Delhi implemented the Autonomous Scheme in 1979. The M H College is one of the pioneering institutions of Madhya Pradesh that adopted the autonomous system in the Higher Education in 1988-89. On the recommendation of UGC peer team the Autonomous status of the college has been extended up to the year 2012 - 2013. NAAC accredited the college with A grade in 2012. The college was selected in the UGC scheme "Colleges with Potential for Excellence" in 2004. That time M H College of H Sc & Science for Women was the only Women college of the MP to be selected with 73 other colleges from all over the country.

ICFRE - Tropical Forest Research Institute, Jabalpur and Govt. M.H. College of Home Science and Science for Women (Autonomous) Jabalpur (M.P.) have agreed to collaborate with the following general provisions and terms :

Article 1 : Objective

Providing a general framework for long term collaboration and mutual understanding in areas of mutual interest, pertaining to develop tropical ecosystem, collaboration in education and publication between ICFRE- Tropical Forest Research Institute and Govt. M.H. College of Home Science and Science for Women (Autonomous) Jabalpur (M.P.).

Article 2: Scope of Collaboration

Subject to terms, this MoU signed by authorized representatives of each party, the parties hereby agree to cooperate as follows:

Article 4: Management

Director/ Group Coordinator Research (GCR)/HOD of the First Party and Registrar/Head of the Institution of the second party will be responsible to workout operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.

The Advisory Committee will meet at least once in a year alternatively in the institutions of the first party and second party to review the activities. This meeting shall include presentation on the academic and research activities, which should be open to the scientists, faculty and students.

Article 5: Implementation

To implement this Memorandum, the following is mutually understood and agreed:

- Two nominees from each institution will constitute a Joint Coordination Committee to oversee collaboration between two parties.
- Each institution will nominate one of its expert members as its representative in charge of any cooperative program on each identified thematic area.
- Proposals for collaborative research work under this Memorandum will be submitted through the normal procedures of each institution.
- Individual projects/programmes of research work developed under this
 memorandum and/ or capacity building programmes will be subject of individual
 agreements in writing clearly spelling out commitments and liabilities of both the
 parties and where appropriate will be jointly developed and executed by the
 nominees of both the parties.
- Each party will ensure appropriate protection of Intellectual Property Rights generated from cooperative pursuant to MoU, consistent with laws, rules and regulations of India.
- Progress of work of any individual collaborative research project/programme will be reviewed and approved by designated project officers of both parties, in accordance with its individual agreement.
- The final approval of any collaborative research project/programme will depend on the availability of the guaranteed support funds.

- The use of scientific equipments by either of parties will be allowed by either side on the realization of charges in vogues. However, owing to signing of this MoU there will not be any financial implications on the part of either parties.
- There shall be an exchange of scientists, faculty and students for academic research and training purposes. Wherever possible as per extent fee.
- Both parties understand that all financial agreement will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on availability of funds.
