On May 22, the students made posters on voting and gave a message of awareness about voting, in which 22 students participated.



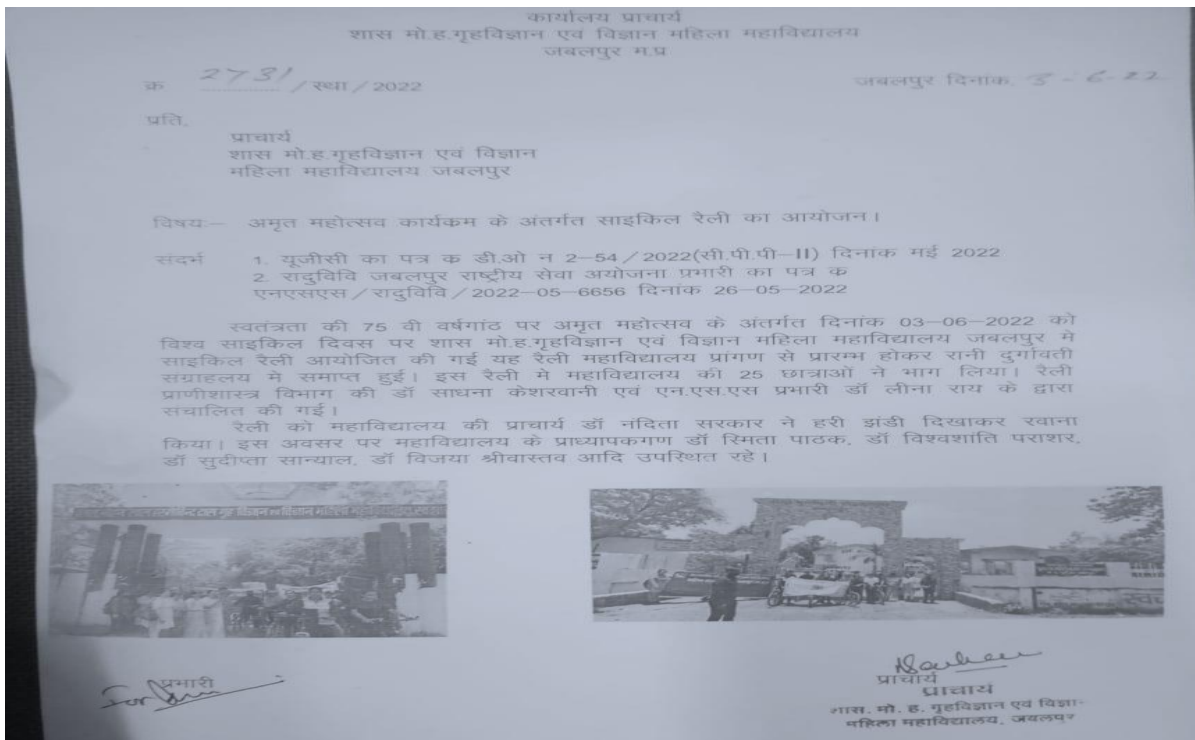
On the occasion of World, No Tobacco Day on 31st May, a poster competition was organised in which 15 girl students participated.

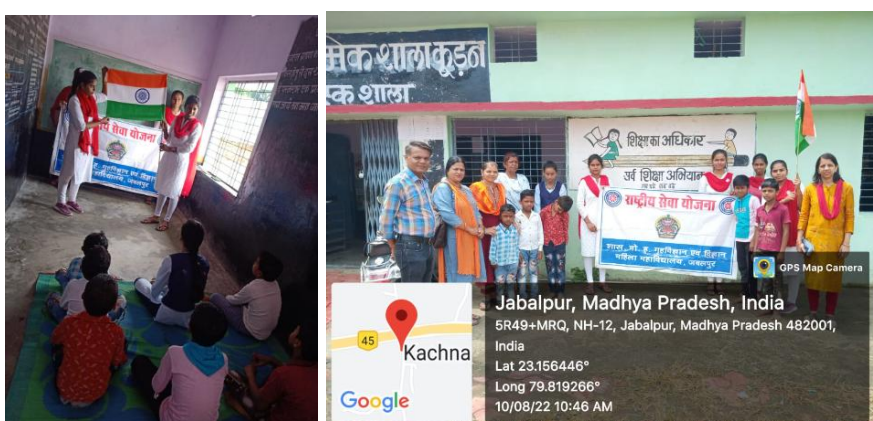
As many as 200 girl students participated in the programmes organised by the students during the **Independence Week from August 8 to 15**
