#### Aims of the Research Policy

Our research policy provides a extensive framework to the research activities with the following objectives:

### Objectives of research policy

- To provide a proper coordination of all activities of research in the college aligning these to the vision and missions of the college and national development goals through Research and development Cell of the college.
- To identify and inform researchers regarding the relevant research opportunities announced by different academic, research, industry or government organizations.
- To support researchers for applying various national and international funding agencies like DST, CSIR and DBT etc and receive funding to conduct research /seminar/workshop/FDP.

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- To promote interdisciplinary research and establish techniques for preparing and undertaking multidisciplinary joint research projects as well as involving external agencies/experts in such projects.
- To raise awareness about intellectual property rights, patents, and patent applications, with the goal of motivating others to apply.
- To take initiative for granting study leave, duty leave, seed money from Janbhagidari Samiti, reduction in workload, etc. to deserving faculty members for advanced research.
- To identify and justify linkage including MOUs for long term relationships with national and international research and industry organizations for broadening the scope of research opportunities and funding options available to the faculties and students of the college.
- To promote collaborations and linkage for higher learning and advance research with academic institutions as well as Industry of both national and international level.
- To encourage and promote the publication of Research work in reputed academic International and National journals of UGC CARE listed with high impact factor and also to facilitate the presentation of the research work through academic events like workshops/seminars/conferences etc.
- To educate all academics and research Scholars on the ethical and legal standards of research.

For ensuring the quality of all research activities including innovative practices of the college with highest standards of ethics and integrity in the conduct of their research and follow the following Code of ethics.

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## CODE OF ETHICS FOR RESEARCH

- All researchers pursuing research in the college are expected to maintain high standards of integrity, honesty and professionalism in respect of all the work undertaken by them.
- Protocols of ethics and laws related to research should be adopted in the college without any conflicts.
- Since the college is affiliated to R. D. V. V. Jabalpur the college follows the regulations of the University and U.G.C. regarding plagiarism and professional misconduct in research.
- A Ph.D. thesis submitted from the Institution is screened by R.
  D. V. V. Jabalpur for plagiarism before submission. Regarding paper publications, each researcher can avail the facility in the university to check for plagiarism.
- Whenever a research paper is to be published in UGC CARE listed /peer reviewed journals, the research committee has to check the originality in the content.
- An ethics committee has been constituted and a Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) is adopted for monitoring research activities of the college. The objective of this SOP is to contribute to the effective functioning of the Committee by ensuring a qualitative and consistent ethical review mechanism for health and biomedical research involving human participants.
- The installed equipment and instruments in college must be shared among college colleagues for their own research.
