Never Plagiarize. Honor patents, copyrights and other forms of intellectual property.

Confidentiality '

Protect confidential communications, such as papers or grants submitted for publication, personnel records, patient records etc.

Responsible Publication

Publish in order to advance research and avoid duplicate publication.

Social Responsibility

Strive to promote social good and prevent social harms through research.

Competence

Maintain and improve your own professional competence and expertise through lifelong education and learning,

Legality

Know and obey relevant laws and institutional and governmental policies.

Animal Care

Show proper care and respect for animals when using them in research. Do not conduct unnecessary or poorly designed animal experiments.

Human subject Protection

When conducting research on human subjects minimize harms and maximize benefits'; respect human dignity.
